Fireworks

FUN & DANGER

DON'T FORGET ---New laws have been brought in that now mean that you can no longer set off fireworks between the hours of 11pm to 7 am. If caught you can face a fine of £80
It is also now illegal to be in possession of fireworks if you are below 18 years of age

Follow the Fireworks Code

- Keep fireworks in a sealed box or tin
- Use them one at a time, replacing the lid immediately
- **NEVER** put fireworks in your pocket
- Read the instructions carefully, using a torch or hand lamp **NEVER** use a naked flame
- Light fireworks at arms length using a taper or a firework lighter
- Stand well back and **NEVER** return to a firework after it has been lit, it could explode in your face
- Ensure that all children with fireworks are well supervised
- **NEVER** throw fireworks
- Keep all pets and animals indoors
- Take care of sparklers, wear gloves to hold them and dispose of sparklers in a bucket of water as soon as they are finished

Dog Poop

The 'YUKKIE' facts

You can get a £50 'on the spot' fine for being caught emptying your dog

There are 6 dog bins on the Broomwood where you can dispose of your dogs poop safely

Broomwood has a regular Dog Warden patrol

This campaign by the BCA & Local Health Visitors aims to make dog owners more responsible for their mess and increase awareness of the problems associated with it.



Dog faeces left in public places pose a great danger to other users of the area. Children especially are at risk from Toxicaris, a disease caused by the eggs of round worms which can lead to permanent blindness. Faeces also harbour other diseases and bacteria and cause damaging changes in the ecology of an area due to the fertilisers in the faeces.

Broomwoodvoice says 'We want to promote keeping local public spaces clean and in a fit state for use by everyone. We also want to safeguard our environment for the benefit of all'
