Christchurch Hall to go

Broomwood is set to lose another community building as plans for the disposal of Christchurch Hall at the junction between Mainwood Road & Thorley Lane go on apace. The Hall, which is the home for a number of vibrant groups, has not been taking new bookings for the last two years. Recently it has had to bear the brunt of a lot of attacks by vandals resulting in many broken windows.

The following statement was issued on behalf of the Parochial Church Council by the Revd Canon John Sutton on 7th October.

As part of an ongoing strategy of mission the Parochial Church Council (PCC) of the Parish of Timperley has been undertaking a review of its buildings.

One element of this is that the PCC decided some nine months ago that Christ Church Hall would become surplus to our requirements; and that as the building is coming to the end of its useful life (without major financial investment) and has become a target for vandalism the site should in due course be sold.

All the church activities at present held in the Hall will be accommodated either at the newly built Holy Cross Church or in the soon to be reordered Christ Church.

Plans are well advanced to make major changes within the building of Christ Church to provide a meeting room with toilets and kitchen under the existing gallery. Such a room will be used by our Sunday Schools and the Church Organisations which at present use the Hall.

The timing of this is difficult to predict because a number of legal steps have to be gone through. It is anticipated that if the various legal permissions are forthcoming the work will be completed within the next twelve months.

Consequently it is not possible to put a time-scale on the sale of Christ Church Hall as the two projects are clearly inextricably linked. In the meantime the Church will continue to use the Hall as at present. As soon as it is known we will announce the date of it's closure.
