## **Ring and Ride Correction**

Following last months article we are pleased to print the following correction clarifying who is eligible to use the service Ring and Ride provide a door-to-door minibus service for people who find it very difficult to use ordinary public transport. For example, you may have: - difficulties getting to and from main public transport routes and services or difficulties getting on and off public transport or a fear or phobia of using ordinary public transport.

In some cases it can also be used short term, for example if you have broken and arm or leg or have a short term illness that causes problems for you using ordinary public transport. Again if you fall into any of these categories then Ring and Ride is there to make your life easier.
